MOZZARELLA STORE PIZZA & CAFFE

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to MOZZARELLA STORE PIZZA & CAFFE upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 822 N. Michigan Ave.. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be twenty point one seven (20.17) feet in length and five point seven five (5.75) feet in width, area #2 shall be fifteen point three nine (15.39) feet in length and five point seven five (5.75) feet in width, area #3 shall be forty-five point eight one (45.81) feet in length and four point five (4.5) feet in width, area #4 shall be forty-seven point three seven (47.37) feet in length and four point five (4.5) feet in width for a total of six hundred twenty-three point seven eight (623.78) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along E. TOWER CT/ MICHIGAN AVE, E. PEARSON STREET. The compensation for said space and the days and hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall be as follows:

Monday thru Thursday from 8:00 am to 11:00 pm; Friday & Saturday from 8:00 am to 11:59 pm; Sunday from 8:00 am to 10:00 pm.
Compensation: \$1,434.69
SEATING CAPACITY: 30


Sidewalk Cafe Permit and approved plan must be posted at all times.

This grant of privilege #1145226 for a sidewalk cafe shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-800 through 10-28-885 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the directions of the Commissioner of Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, and the Commissioner of Transportation.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority for the above named privilege is herein given and granted from and after March 01, 2020 through and including February 28, 2021.
