40	6348 North Ridge Boulevard; 6348 North Ridge Boulevard (west side) from a point 110 feet south of West Devon Avenue to a point 40 feet south thereof; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), All Times, All Days -- (17-00098921) [O2016-8993]
