WHEREAS, The Honorable Howard Coble practiced law for 20 years before he was named Secretary of Revenue under Governor James Holshouser; and

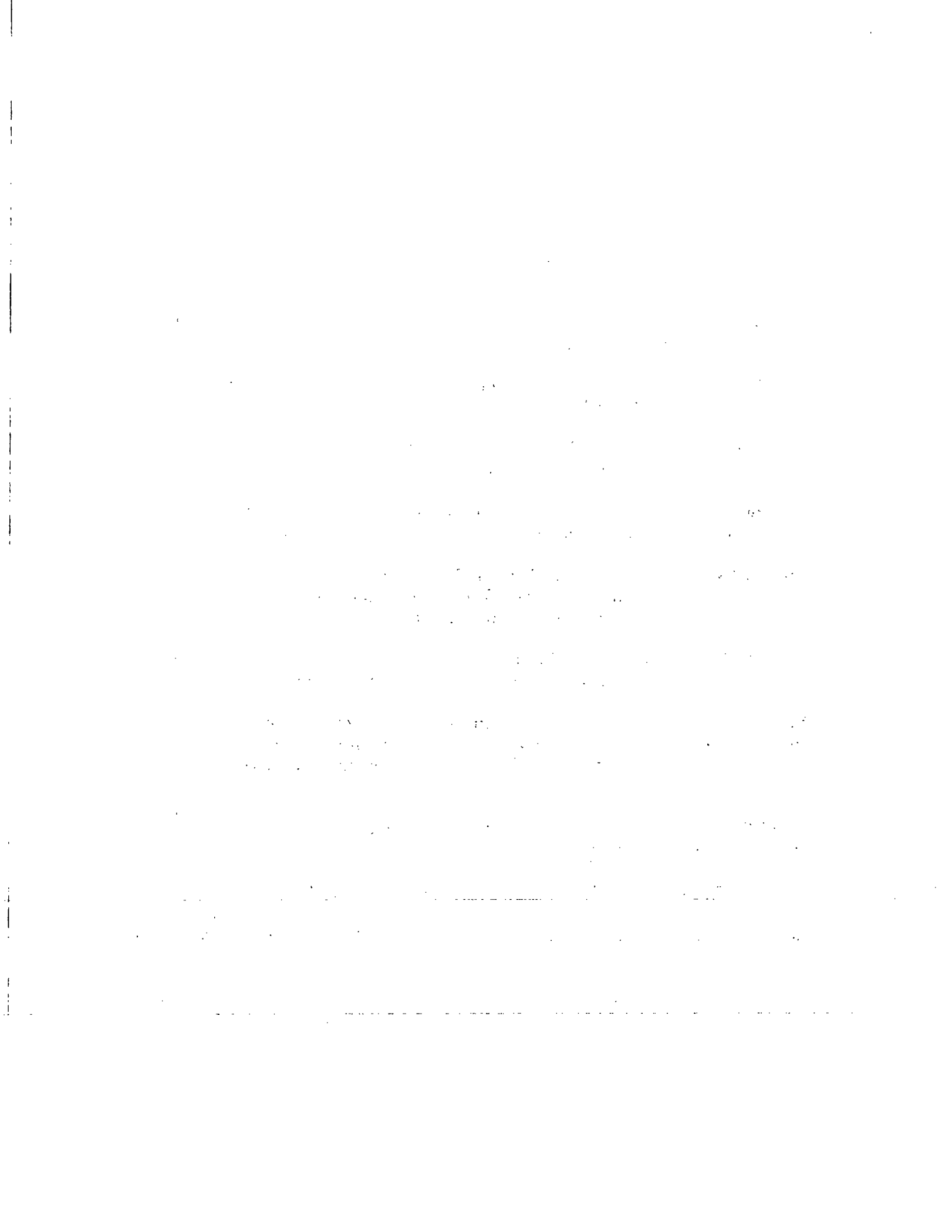


