WHEREAS, On June 12, 1965, Stephen Bogusiewicz married the love of his life, Laurie Keohane, and through this union had two daughters, Laurie Ann and Christine, who had granddaughters Lauren, Macyn, and Arianna; and,

WHEREAS, Stephen Bogusiewicz bought his Belmont/Cragin home on Wrightwood in 1976, where to this day, his wife, daughter Christine, and granddaughter, Arianne still resides at; and,

WHEREAS, Stephen Bogusiewicz became a Chicago Police Officer in 1967 and spent his entire career working in the 18th District until he was mandatorily retired on his 63rd birthday in 2006; and,

WHEREAS, Stephen Bogusiewicz loved his job and the City of Chicago so much that he encouraged his daughter, Laurie Ann to follow in his footsteps. Laurie has been a Chicago Police Officer for over 16 years and proudly wears her father's badge which has only been worn by the family since it was first issued in 1967; and,
