WEIGHT WATCHERS NORTH AMERICA, INC  
Acct. No. 14460 - 8  
Permit No. 1144935

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to WEIGHT WATCHERS NORTH AMERICA, INC, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use one (1) sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 4444 N. Broadway .

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along N. Broadway:

One (1) at thirteen point seven five (13.75) feet in length, three point five (3.5) feet in height and twelve (12) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1144935 herein granted the sum of three hundred (\$300.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

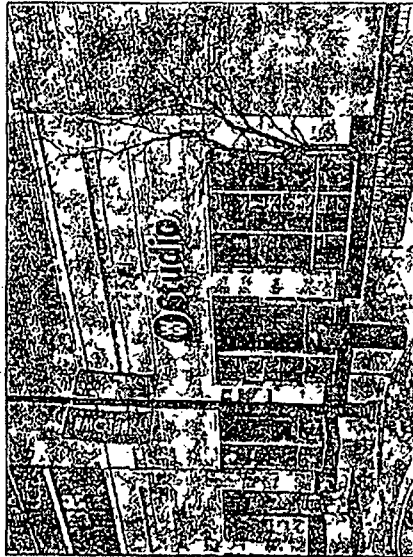
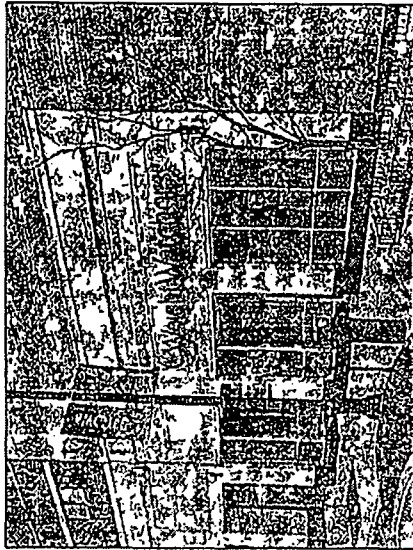
The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

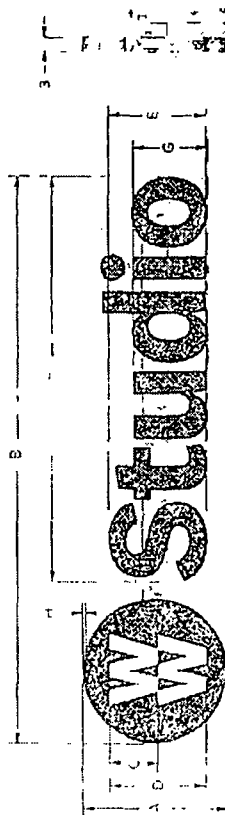
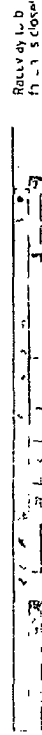

The sixth group of people who are not allowed to enter the country are those who are on the "denied" list. This list is also maintained by the Department of Homeland Security and includes individuals who are considered a threat to national security but are not on the "no-fly", "sensitive but untrusted", "prohibited", "watch", or "restricted" lists. 7. The seventh group of people who are not allowed to enter the country are those who are on the "banned" list. This list is also maintained by the Department of Homeland Security and includes individuals who are considered a threat to national security but are not on the "no-fly", "sensitive but untrusted", "prohibited", "watch", "restricted", or "denied" lists. 8. The eighth group of people who are not allowed to enter the country are those who are on the "excluded" list. This list is also maintained by the Department of Homeland Security and includes individuals who are considered a threat to national security but are not on the "no-fly", "sensitive but untrusted", "prohibited", "watch", "restricted", "denied", or "banned" lists. 9. The ninth group of people who are not allowed to enter the country are those who are on the "disqualified" list. This list is also maintained by the Department of Homeland Security and includes individuals who are considered a threat to national security but are not on the "no-fly", "sensitive but untrusted", "prohibited", "watch", "restricted", "denied", "banned", or "excluded" lists. 10. The tenth group of people who are not allowed to enter the country are those who are on the "ineligible" list. This list is also maintained by the Department of Homeland Security and includes individuals who are considered a threat to national security but are not on the "no-fly", "sensitive but untrusted", "prohibited", "watch", "restricted", "denied", "banned", "excluded", or "disqualified" lists.

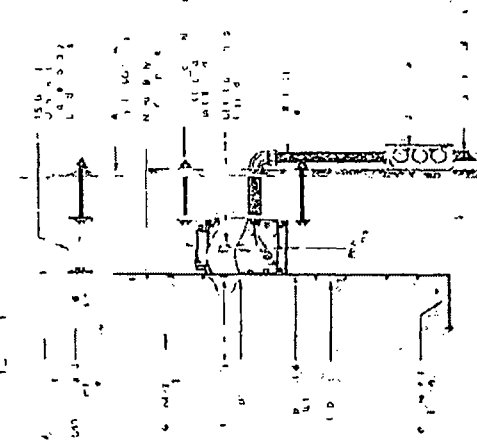
