**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Philip Henderson Hoff also was known as a major force in changing Vermont from a Republican to a Democratic state; and

**WHEREAS,** The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of the Honorable Philip Henderson Hoff serve as an example to all; and


