ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The Director of Revenue is directed to install parking meters at the following locations:

- W. Lake Street, south side of the street, from Clark Street to Dearborn Avenue.
- W. Lake Street, north side of the street, from Garvey Court to Clark Street.
- 200 block of N. Franklin, west side of the street
- S. LaSalle Street, west side of the street, from Monroe Street heading north to the first alley
- W. Randolph Street, south side of the street, from N. State Street to N. Dearborn Avenue
- N. Jefferson Street, both sides of the street, from W. Kinzie Avenue to W. Prairie Alley.

SECTION 2. Section 9-64-206 of the Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the language underscored and by deleting the language struck through as follows:

9-64-206 Parking meters—hours of operation

Notwithstanding any prior ordinance establishing different hours of operation, the hours of operation for a parking meter shall be as follows:

- (c) On non-residential streets in the area within the boundaries set forth in Section 9-64-205(a), parking meters shall operate 24 hours per day, Monday through Sunday, except that meters shall operate:

(3) From 6:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M., Monday through Friday, and all day Saturday and Sunday until 7am Monday at:


42.1 W.Lake Street, south side of the street, from N.Clark Street to N.Dearborn Avenue.

(4) From 7:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M., Monday through Friday, and all day Saturday and Sunday until 7am Monday at:

42.2 W. Lake Street, north side of the street, from N.Garvey Court to N. Clark Street

(f) The time limits set forth above shall not replace any other more restrictive parking or standing restrictions and do not relieve a person from the duty to observe other and more restrictive provisions prohibiting or limiting the standing or parking of vehicles in specified places or at specified times.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
