WHEREAS, The Honorable Edward Derwinski has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of eighty-five; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Edward Derwinski was the loving and devoted husband of Bonnie; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Edward Derwinski was the father of Maureen and Michael, the step-father of Maggie and Kevin, and the grandfather of seven to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities which he possessed in abundance; and

WHEREAS, In 1989 President George H.W. Bush appointed the Honorable Edward Derwinski as the nation's first Secretary of Veterans Affairs; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Edward Derwinski was among the United States troops which occupied Japan at the end of World War II; and

WHEREAS, Prior to his Cabinet position, the Honorable Edward Derwinski served as an Illinois Congressman for nearly a quarter century, representing Chicago's South Side and the surrounding suburbs; and

WHEREAS, Those who worked with the Honorable Edward Derwinski remember him as a principled and effective leader and a committed patriot; and

WHEREAS, To his beloved family, the Honorable Edward Derwinski imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this fifteenth day of February, 2012, do hereby commemorate the Honorable Edward Derwinski for his grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to his family; and
