Maureen showed her great sense of humor in her response to the cease and desist letter that was sent to her by the Fox Corporation for referencing The Simpsons in her bar. Maureen changed the name of her version of the Flaming Moe cocktail to the “Flaming Cease and Desist” and framing the letter and displaying it at the bar; and


