**ORDINANCE**

**EXEMPTION OF LOYOLA UNIVERSITY CHICAGO  
FROM PAYMENT OF CITY PERMIT, LICENSE AND  
INSPECTION FEES FOR PERIOD ENDING  
AUGUST 15, 2013**

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Buildings, the Commissioner of Environment, the Commissioner of Transportation, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, the Commissioner of Fire, the Commissioner of Water Management, the Commissioner of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Director of Revenue, are hereby directed to issue all necessary permits, all on-site water/sewer inspection fees, all water/sewer plan review fees, free of charge, notwithstanding other ordinances of the City of Chicago to the contrary,

To: Loyola University Chicago


For: erection and maintenance of the building  
On the premises known as: 6330 North Sheridan Road

Said building and all appurtenances thereto shall be used exclusively for charitable purposes and shall not be leased or otherwise used with a view to profit and the work thereon shall be done in accordance with plans submitted and all appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago and departmental requirements of various departments of the City of Chicago, and said building and all appurtenances thereto shall be constructed and maintained so that they shall comply in all respects with the requirements of the appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago for the issuance of all permits and licenses.

SECTION 2. Loyola University Chicago, a not-for-profit Illinois Corporation, located at 6525 North Sheridan Road, Chicago, IL 60626, engaged in non-profit religious, charitable and related activities, shall be exempt from the payment of City license fees and shall be entitled to the cancellation of warrants for the collection for inspection fees.

SECTION 3. The Loyola University Chicago shall be entitled to a refund of City fees, which it has paid and to which it is exempt pursuant to Section 1 and 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in force for the period of November 16, 2011 through August 15, 2013.
