Montrose Avenue, be and the same is hereby amended by striking there from, the following:

W. Montrose Ave., northside, from a point 25 feet west of N. Melvina, to a point 29 feet west thereof; 15 minute loading zone, use flashing lights, tow zone after 15 minutes, 1:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday;

and inserting in lieu thereof:

No Parking Disabled Loading Zone, 1:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m., Monday thru Friday  
Tow Zone  
(Public Benefit)

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force herein after its passage and publication.


