An ordinance, introduced by Alderman Pat Dowell (3rd Ward), amending Municipal Code Section 2-92-490 of the Municipal Code to further regulate duties of Chief Procurement Officer regarding electronic directory maintenance requirements for certified Certification Eligible and Minority-Owned Businesses. (O2020-3294)

This Committee will have public comment at the beginning of the Committee Meeting. Each person participating in public comment shall have up to three minutes to address all items on the agenda during this public comment period. The Committee will not conduct separate public comment for each agenda item. The public comment period will be limited to 30 minutes overall, with each participant limited to three minutes.
