#### <u>ORDINANCE</u>

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2-68-030 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

#### 2-68-030 Chief information officer - Powers and duties.

The chief information officer shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

(Omitted text is not affected by this ordinance)

- (i) to enter into agreements with the Illinois Secretary of State in order to access, use or share data useful or necessary to the carrying out of City functions. The chief information officer may enter into such agreements, which may include provisions providing indemnification, directly or through a designee, which may include a designee of another city department if the information at issue directly impacts that other department. The chief information officer or his designee is further authorized to execute such other instruments and to perform such acts, including the expenditure of funds subject to appropriation therefor, as shall be necessary or advisable in connection with the implementation of such agreements, including any renewals thereto.
- (j) to enter into agreements regarding: (i) access to, or use or sharing of, city or third-party data, (ii) cooperative development and ownership of intellectual property, or (iii) incorporating city data or other intellectual property into cooperative work created pursuant to an agreement authorized under this paragraph (j). Any agreement authorized under this paragraph (j) shall not include the expenditure of city funds, but may include provisions providing indemnification. The chief information officer shall provide a quarterly written report to the chairman of the committee on the budget and government operations summarizing, and attaching the text of, any agreements entered into pursuant to this subsection (j) for the preceding calendar quarter.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and approval.
