Chicago Trolley Company
Acct. No. 5752 - 26
Permit No. 1101824

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to Chicago Trolley Company, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use one (1) portable sales Booth on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 620 N. Clark St..

Said Booth(s) at N. Clark measure(s):

One (1) at two point nine five (2.95) feet in length, and two point one seven (2.17) feet in width for a total of six point four (6.4) square feet. Said portable sale booth shall be forty-three (43) inches in height.

Grantee must allow a minimum of at least six (6) feet of clear and unobstructed space for pedestrian passage at all times.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1101824 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.

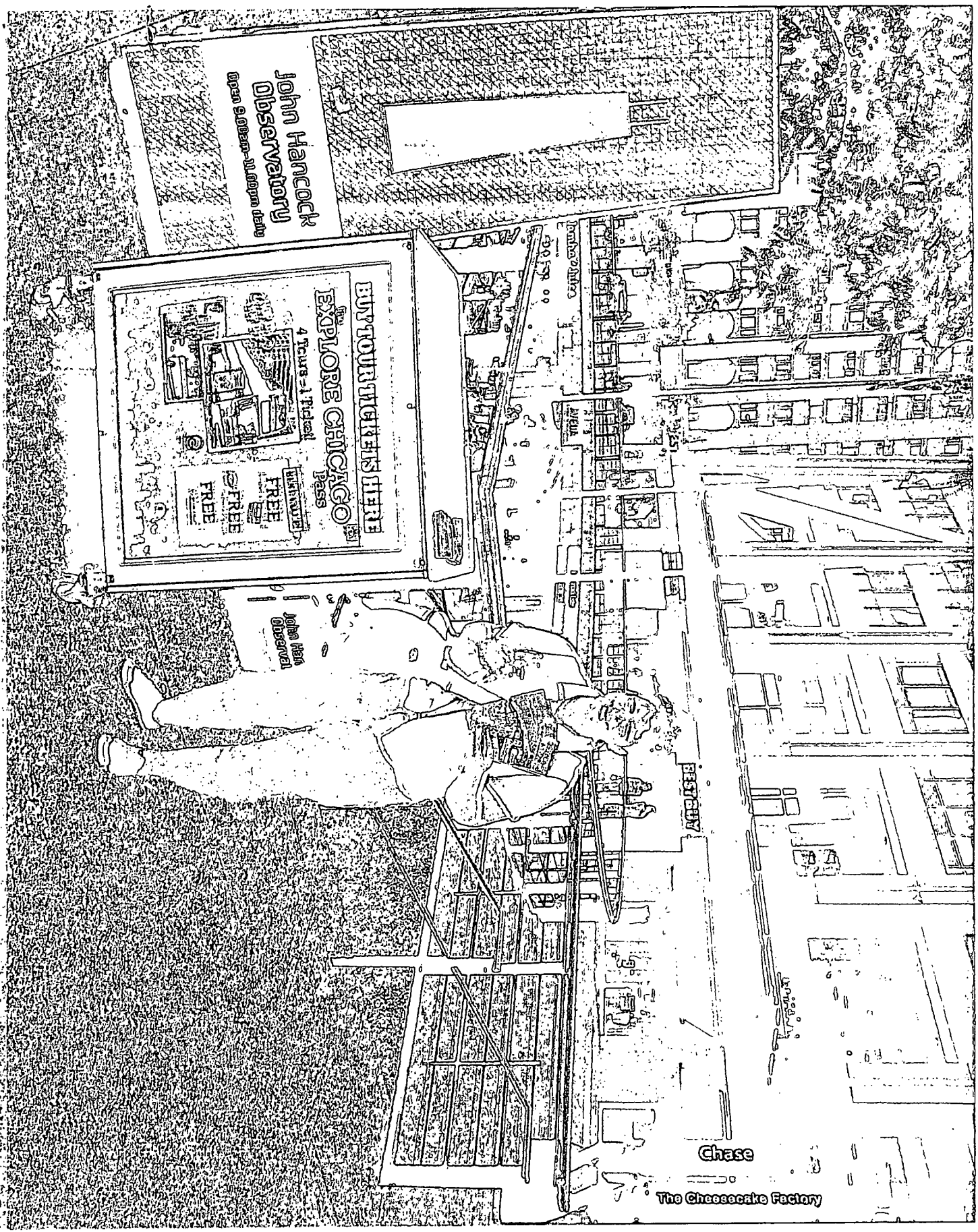
A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
