Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to 2500 Milwaukee LLC, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use five (5) Canopy(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 2500 N. Milwaukee Ave..

Said Canopy(s) at N. Milwaukee measure(s):

One (1) at forty-five point zero four (45.04) feet in length, and two point zero four (2.04) feet in width for a total of ninety-one point eight eight (91.88) square feet.

One (1) at thirty-one point five (31.5) feet in length, and four point two one (4.21) feet in width for a total of one hundred thirty-two point six two (132.62) square feet.

One (1) at eighteen point one seven (18.17) feet in length, and three point three four (3.34) feet in width for a total of sixty point six nine (60.69) square feet.

One (1) at twenty-four point five two (24.52) feet in length, and three point three four (3.34) feet in width for a total of eighty-one point nine (81.9) square feet.

Said Canopy(s) at N. Sacramento measure(s):

One (1) at thirty-two point five (32.5) feet in length, and three point three four (3.34) feet in width for a total of one hundred eight point five five (108.55) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1128060 herein granted the sum of one hundred seventy-five (\$175.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
