**WHEREAS**, John "Jack" Gallapo, Jr., was a sixty-year member of the Cement Masons Union Local #502; and


**WHEREAS**, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of John "Jack" Gallapo, Jr., serve as an example to all; and
