***WHEREAS***, The Reverend Joseph W. Seitz has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of eighty-two; and

***WHEREAS***, The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

***WHEREAS***, The Reverend Joseph W. Seitz attended Christ the King Elementary School, the parish where he served as Pastor Emeritus at the time of his passing; and

***WHEREAS***, The Reverend Joseph W. Seitz was a graduate of Quigley Seminary North and Saint Mary of the Lake Seminary; and

***WHEREAS***, The Reverend Joseph W. Seitz was ordained a Roman Catholic priest on April 12, 1958, and served the Chicago Archdiocese for fifty-four years; and


