BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the B1-1 Neighborhood Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 24-H in the area bounded by

West 95<sup>th</sup> Street; a line 157.53 feet east of and parallel to South Hoyne Avenue; the public alley next south of and parallel to West 95<sup>th</sup> Street (and perpendicular to South Hoyne Avenue); a line 57.53 feet east of and parallel to South Hoyne Avenue,

to those of a B3-1 Community Shopping District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.


