ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Chicago Zoning Ordinance be amended by changing all of the B3-2 Community Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map 11-G in the area bounded by:

West Wilson Avenue; a line 175.50 feet east of and parallel to North Sheridan Road; a line 141 feet south of and parallel to West Wilson Avenue; North Sheridan Road;

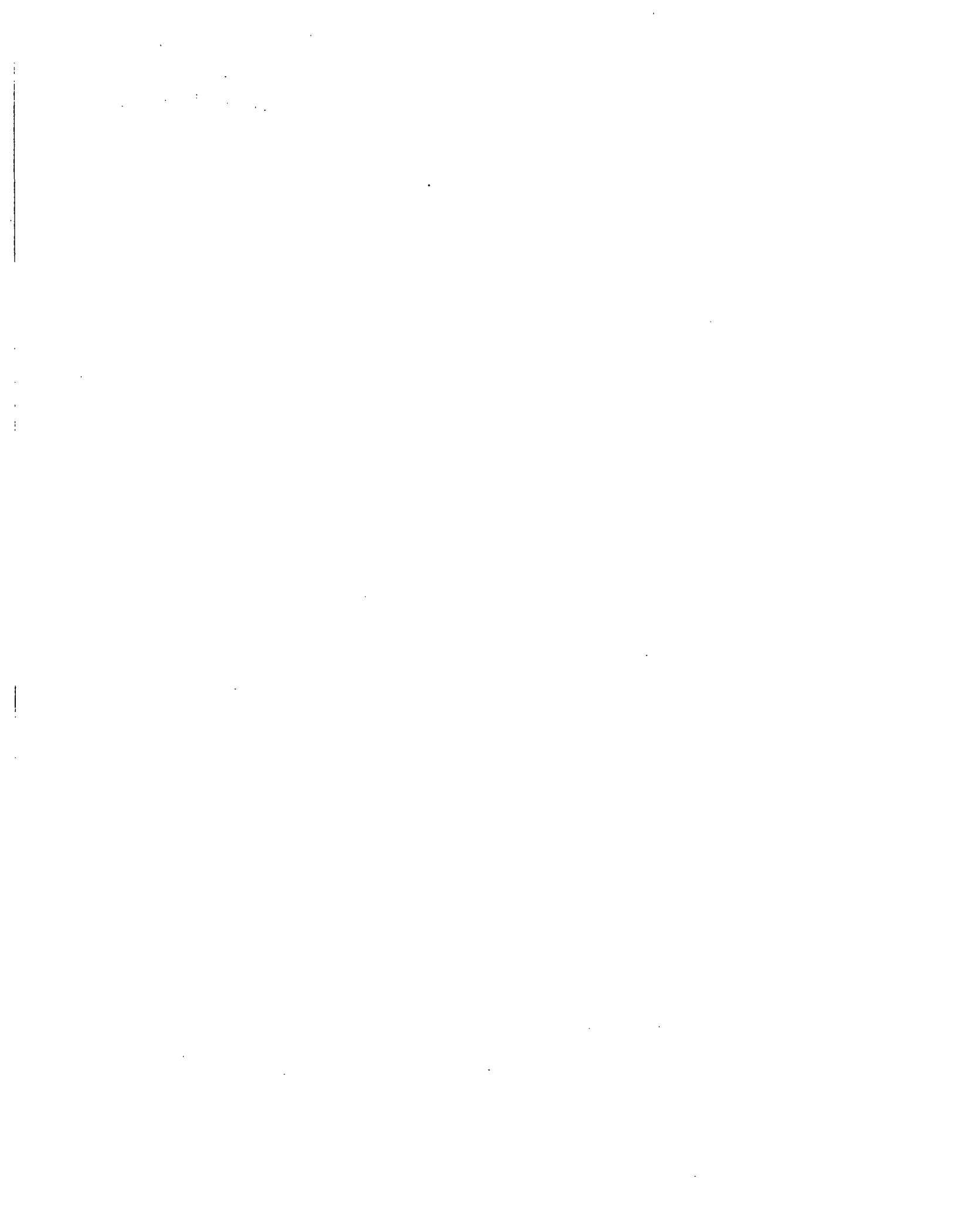
to those of the B3-5 Community Shopping District.

SECTION 2. That the Chicago Zoning Ordinance be amended by changing all of the B3-5 Community Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map 11-G in the area bounded by:

West Wilson Avenue; a line 175.50 feet east of and parallel to North Sheridan Road; a line 141 feet south of and parallel to West Wilson Avenue; North Sheridan Road;

to those of a Residential – Business Planned Development.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.



RESIDENTIAL-BUSINESS PLANNED DEVELOPMENT NO. _____

PLANNED DEVELOPMENT STATEMENTS

1. The area delineated herein as Planned Development Number _____ (“Planned Development”) consists of approximately 24,745 net square feet of property which is depicted on the attached Planned Development Boundary and Property Line Map (“Property”). Sheridan 4557 LLC is the Applicant for this Planned Development, pursuant to authorization from the Property owner.
2. The requirements, obligations and conditions contained within this Planned Development shall be binding upon the Applicant, its successors and assigns and, if different than the Applicant, the legal title holders and any ground lessors. All rights granted hereunder to the Applicant shall inure to the benefit of the Applicant’s successors and assigns and, if different than the Applicant, the legal title holder and any ground lessors. Furthermore, pursuant to the requirements of Section 17-8-0400 of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, the Property, at the time of application for amendments, modifications or changes (administrative, legislative or otherwise) to this Planned Development are made, shall be under single ownership or designated control. Single designated control is defined in Section 17-8-0400 of the Zoning Ordinance in effect as of the date of this Planned Development.
3. All applicable official reviews, approvals or permits are required to be obtained by the Applicant or its successors, assignees or grantees. Any dedication or vacation of streets or alleys or grants of easements or any adjustment of the right-of-way shall require a separate submittal to the Chicago Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) on behalf of the Applicant or its successors, assigns or grantees.

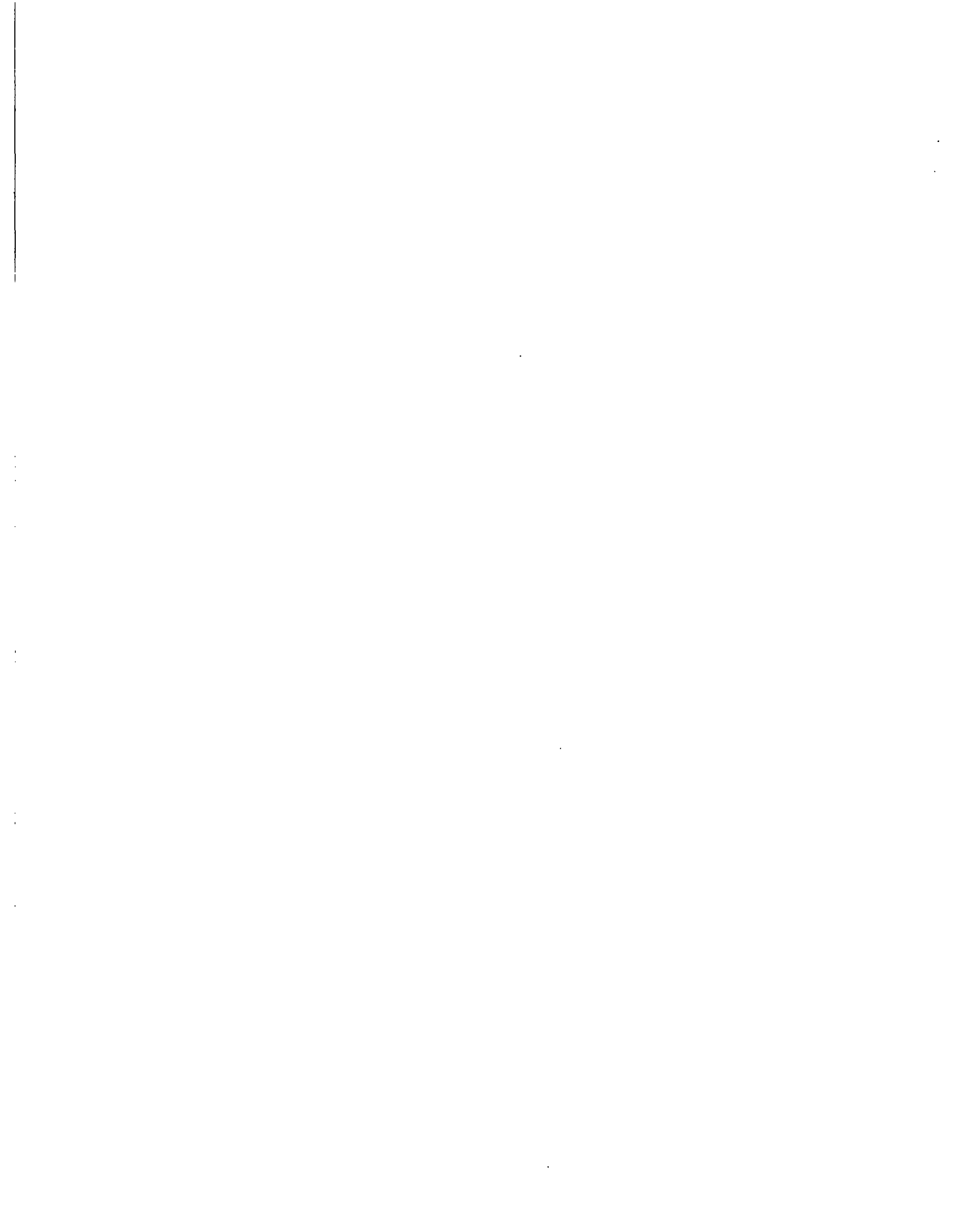
Any requests for grants of privilege, or any items encroaching on the public way, shall be in compliance with the Plans.

Ingress or egress shall be pursuant to the Plans and may be subject to the review and approval of the Chicago Department of Planning and Development (“DPD”) and CDOT. Closure of all or any public street or alley during demolition or construction shall be subject to the review and approval of CDOT.

All work proposed in the public way must be designed and constructed in accordance with CDOT Construction Standards for Work in the Public Way and in compliance with the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago. Prior to the issuance of any Part II approval, the submitted plans must be approved by CDOT.

4. This Plan of Development consists of these 16 Statements, a Bulk Regulations and Data Table, and the following exhibits and plans prepared by Space Architects + Planners and dated _____, 2015 (collectively, the “Plans”): an Existing Zoning Map; an Existing

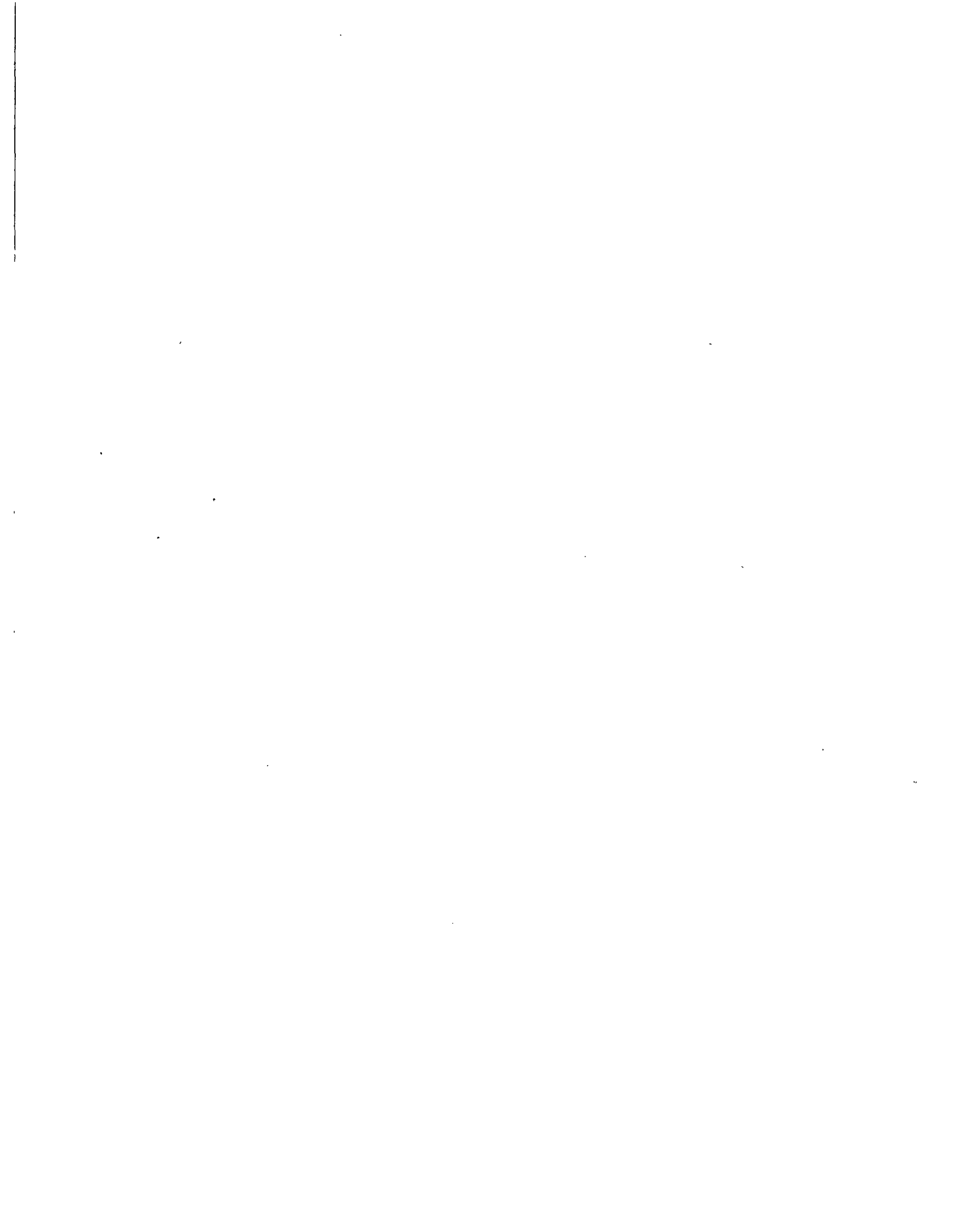
Land Use Map; Planned Development Property and Boundary Line Map; Site Plan; Landscape Plan; Green Roof Plan; and Building Elevations. In any instance where a provision of this Planned Development conflicts with the Chicago Building Code, the Building Code shall control. This Planned Development conforms to the intent and purpose of the Zoning Ordinance, and all requirements thereof, and satisfies the established criteria for approval as a Planned Development. In case of a conflict between the terms of this Planned Development Ordinance and the Zoning Ordinance, this Planned Development Ordinance shall control.

5. The following uses shall be permitted in this Planned Development: All uses allowed in the B3-5 Community Shopping District, including, without limitation, Dwelling Units located above and on the ground floor; Eating and Drinking Establishments; Retail Sales, General; and accessory parking.
6. On-Premise signs and temporary signs, such as construction and marketing signs, shall be permitted within the Planned Development, subject to the review and approval of DPD. Off-Premise signs are prohibited within the boundary of the Planned Development.
7. For purposes of height measurement, the definitions in the Zoning Ordinance shall apply. The height of any building shall also be subject to height limitations, if any, established by the Federal Aviation Administration.
8. The maximum permitted Floor Area Ratio ("FAR") for the Property shall be in accordance with the attached Bulk Regulations and Data Table. For the purposes of FAR calculations and measurements, the definitions in the Zoning Ordinance shall apply. The permitted overall FAR identified in the Bulk Regulations Table has been determined using a Net Site Area of 24,745 square feet.
9. Upon review and determination, "Part II Review", pursuant to Section 17-13-0610 of the Zoning Ordinance, a Part II Review Fee shall be assessed by DPD. The fee, as determined by staff at the time, is final and binding on the Applicant and must be paid to the Department of Revenue prior to the issuance of any Part II approval.
10. The Plans shall be in substantial conformance with the Landscape Ordinance and any other corresponding regulations and guidelines. Final landscape plan review and approval will be by DPD. Any interim reviews associated with site plan review or Part II reviews, are conditional until final Part II approval.
11. The Applicant shall comply with Rules and Regulations for the Maintenance of Stockpiles promulgated by the Commissioners of the Departments of Streets and Sanitation, Fleet and Facility Management and Buildings, under Section 13-32-125 of the Municipal Code, or any other applicable provision of that Code.

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12. The terms and conditions of development under this Planned Development Ordinance may be modified administratively, pursuant to section 17-13-0611-A of the Zoning Ordinance, by the Zoning Administrator upon the application for such a modification by the Applicant, its successors or assigns and, if different than the Applicant, the legal title holders and any ground lessees of the Property.
13. The Applicant acknowledges that it is in the public interest to design, construct and maintain the project in a manner which promotes, enables and maximizes universal access throughout the Property. Plans for all buildings and improvements on the Property shall be reviewed and approved by the Mayor's Office for People with Disabilities to ensure compliance with all applicable laws and regulations related to access for persons with disabilities and to promote the highest standard of accessibility.
14. The Applicant acknowledges that it is in the public interest to design, construct, renovate and maintain all buildings in a manner that provides healthier indoor environments, reduces operating costs and conserves energy and natural resources. The Applicant shall seek LEED certification, and provide a green roof of not less than 50% of the net roof area equivalent to an actual total of _____ square feet.
15. The Applicant acknowledges and agrees that the change of zoning of the underlying zoning district of this Planned Development No. _____ from the B3-2 Community Shopping District to the B3-5 Community Shopping District for construction of this Planned Development triggers the requirements of Section 2-45-110 of the Municipal Code (the "Affordable Housing Ordinance"). Any developer of a "residential housing project" within the meaning of the Affordable Housing Ordinance ("Residential Project") must: (i) develop affordable housing units as part of the Residential Project; (ii) pay a fee in lieu of the development of affordable housing units; or (iii) any combination of (i) and (ii). In accordance with these requirements and the Affordable Housing Profile Form attached hereto as Exhibit A, the Applicant has agreed to provide 14 affordable housing units in the Residential Project for households earning up to 60% of the Chicago Primary Metropolitan Statistical Area median income (the "Affordable Units"), or make a cash payment to the Affordable Housing Opportunity Fund in the amount of \$100,000 per required affordable unit ("Cash Payment"). At the time of each Part II review for the Residential Project, Applicant may update and resubmit the Affordable Housing Profile Form to DPD for review and approval. If the Applicant subsequently reduces the number of dwelling units in the Residential Project, DPD may adjust the requirements of this Statement 15 (i.e., number of Affordable Units and/or amount of Cash Payment) accordingly without amending the Planned Development. Prior to the issuance of any building permits for the Residential Project, including, without limitation, excavation or foundation permits, the Applicant must either make the required Cash Payment, or execute an Affordable Housing Agreement in accordance with Section 2-45-110(i)(2). The terms of the Affordable Housing Agreement and any amendments thereto are incorporated herein by this reference. The Applicant acknowledges and agrees that the Affordable Housing Agreement will be recorded against the Residential Project and will

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constitute a lien against each Affordable Unit. The City shall execute partial releases of the Affordable Housing Agreement prior to or at the time of the sale of each Affordable Unit to an income-eligible buyer at an affordable price, subject to the simultaneous execution and recording of a mortgage, restrictive covenant or similar instrument against such Affordable Unit. The Commissioner of DPD may enforce remedies for breach of the Affordable Housing Agreement, and enter into settlement agreements with respect to any such breach, subject to the approval of the Corporation Counsel, without amending the Planned Development.

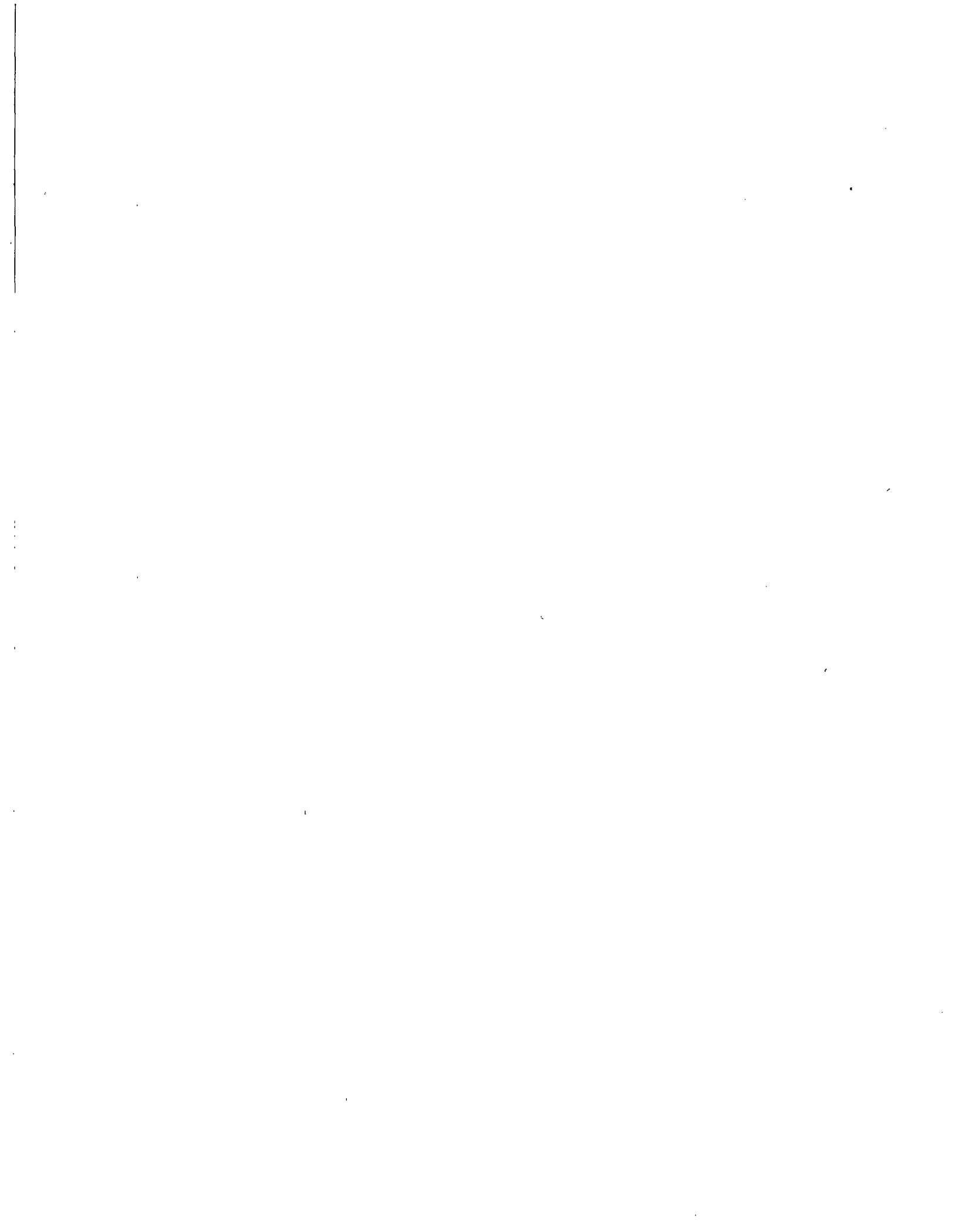
16. This Planned Development shall be governed by Section 17-13-0612 of the Zoning Ordinance. Should this Planned Development Ordinance lapse, the Commissioner of DPD shall initiate a Zoning Map Amendment to rezone the property to the B3-5 Community Shopping District.

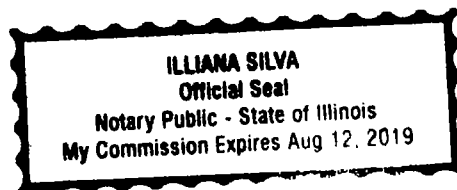

As required by Section 17-13-0107 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago, please be informed that on or about September 24, 2015, the undersigned, on behalf of Sheridan 4557 LLC, (the "Applicant"), intends to file an application to rezone the property located at 943-957 West Wilson and 4545-4557 North Sheridan, Chicago, IL 60640 from B3-2 Community Shopping District to a B3-5 Community Shopping District, then to a Residential-Business Planned Development. A map of the development site is printed on the reverse side of this letter.

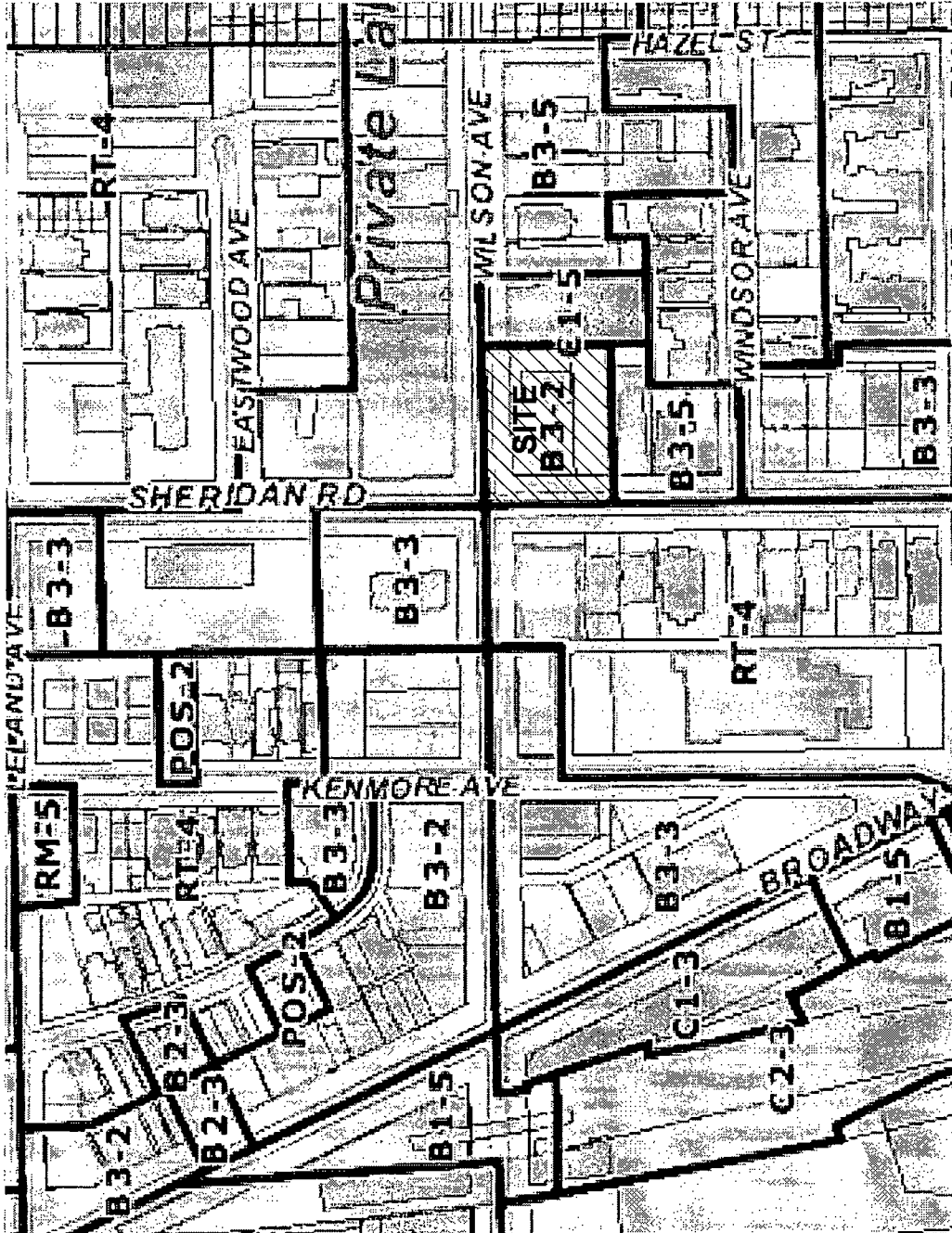

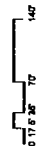

1 ZONING MAP

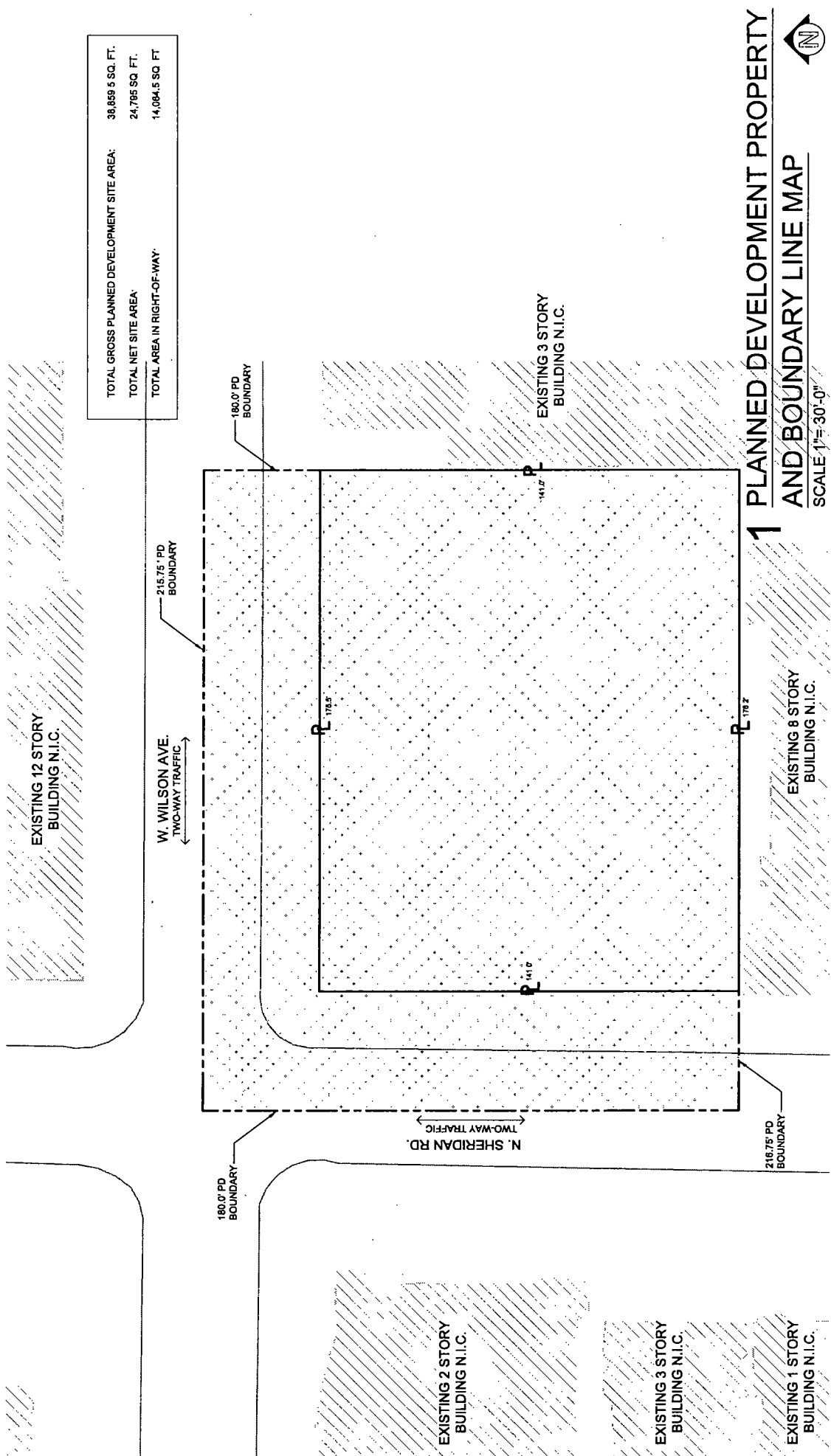

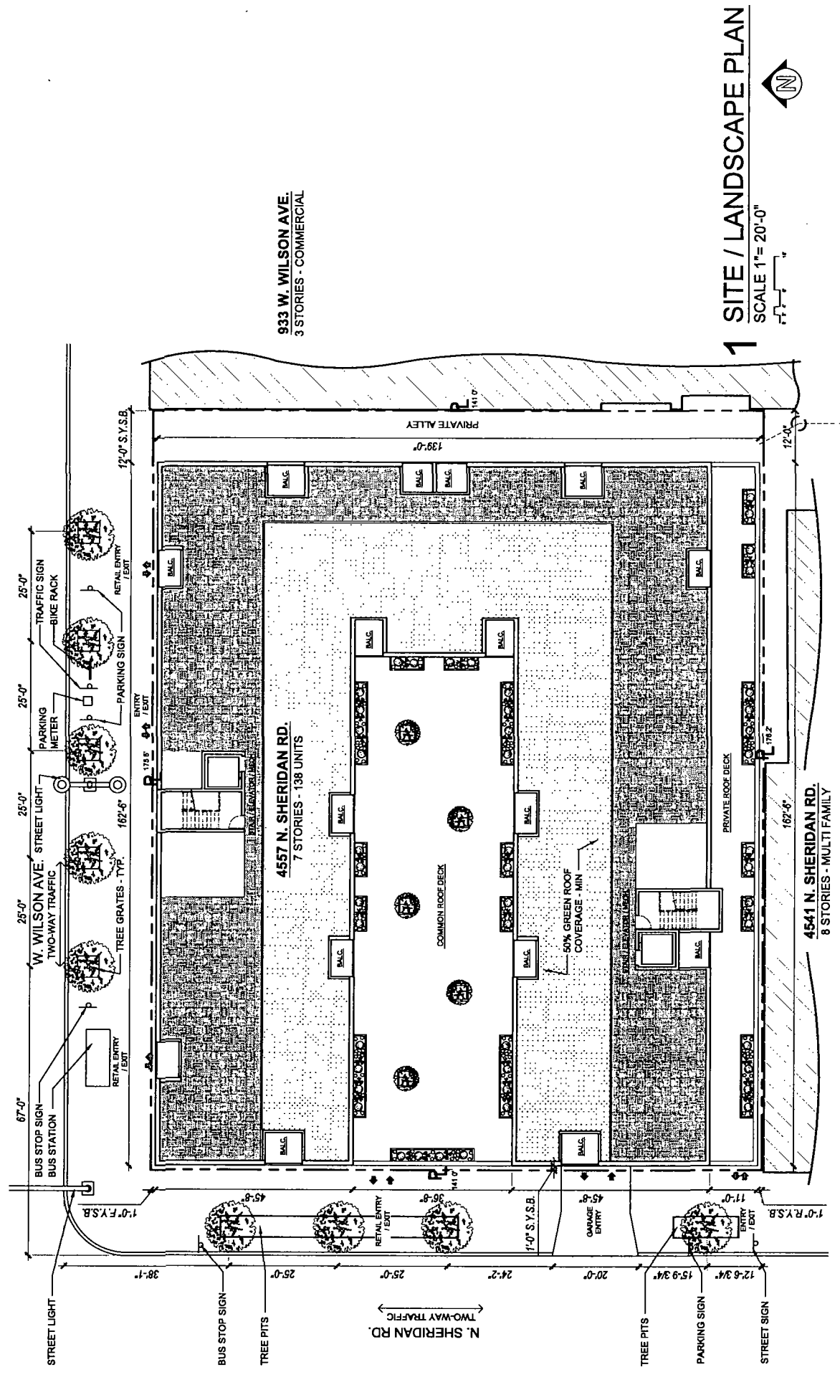

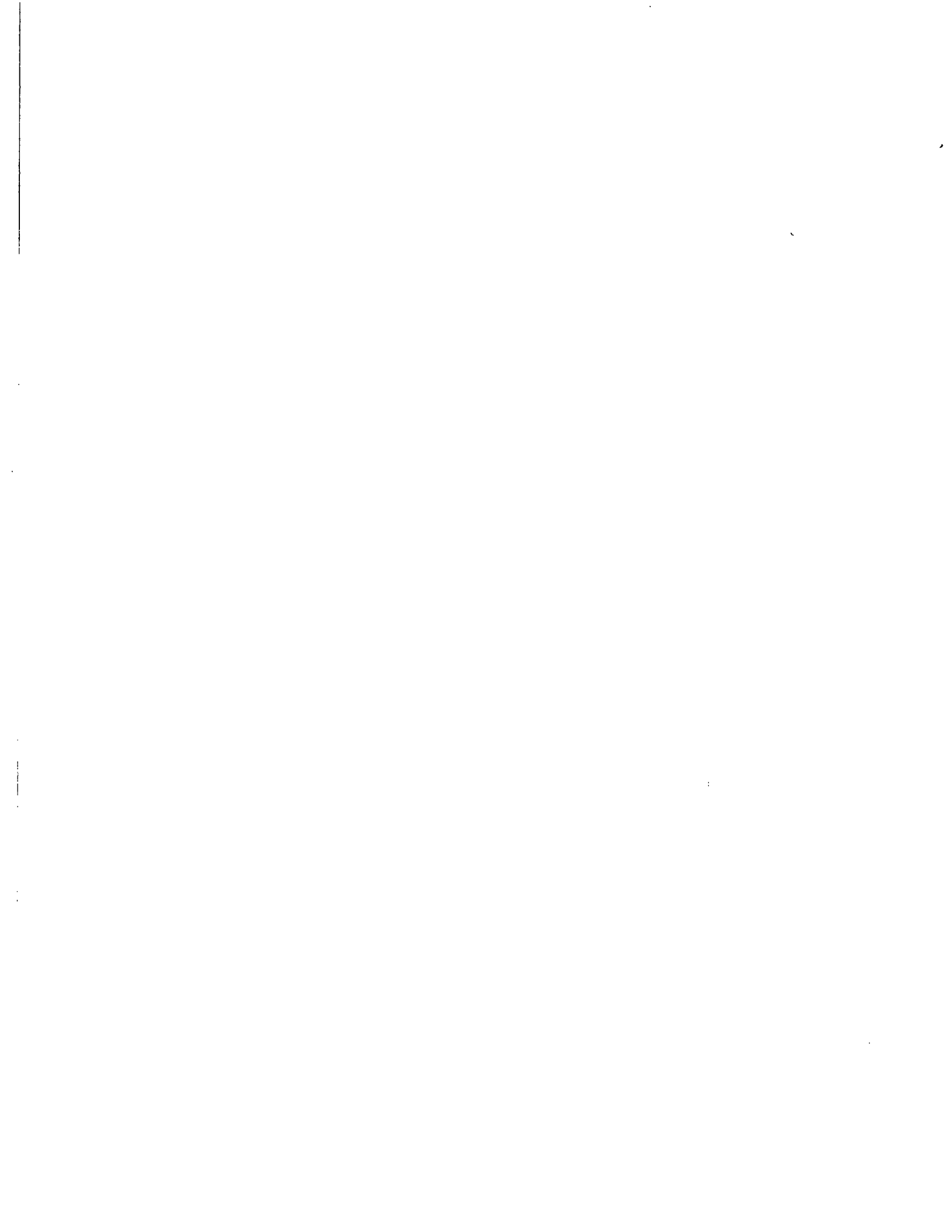
