ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:


SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the C1-2 Neighborhood Commercial District, as shown on Map 3-H in the area bounded by:

West Chicago Avenue, a line 24 feet West of North Leavitt Avenue, the alley South and parallel to West Chicago Avenue, and West of North Leavitt Avenue.





In accordance with the requirements for an Amendment to the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, please be informed that on or about December 6, 2017, the undersigned will file an application for a change in zoning from C1-2 Neighborhood Commercial District to B2-3 Neighborhood Mixed-Use District for the property located at 2200 West Chicago Avenue, Chicago, Illinois.

The zoning change is needed on the existing six (6) unit building to legalize the existing use of the storefront as a residential unit. The building currently exceeds the maximum floor area ratio allowed under the current zoning district (C1-2). The footprint and height at the property will not change.
