

**AMEND SINGLE DIRECTION:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.**

Repeal ordinance passed October 1, 1997, page 53230 which reads: **N. Hamlin Avenue** from **W. Wabansia Avenue** to **W. North Avenue**, Southerly -- 11-00468210 - O2011-804 (26<sup>th</sup> Ward);

**SECTION 2.**

Amend ordinance passed March 9, 1983, page 13669 which reads: **N. Sacramento Avenue** from **W. Montrose Avenue** to **W. Irving Park Road**, Southerly by striking **W. Irving Park Road** and inserting in lieu thereof: the first alley north of **W. Irving Park Road** -- 11-00804280 - O2011-2078 (33<sup>rd</sup> Ward);

**SECTION 3.**

Repeal ordinance passed May 14, 1980 page 3127 which reads: **N. Rockwell Street** from **W. Logan Boulevard** service drive to **N. Avondale Avenue**, Southerly -- 11-00807535 - O2011-1465 (35<sup>th</sup> Ward);

**SECTION 4.**

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
