## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, Daniel Schroeder is retiring from a career as a teacher at St. John Fisher School on June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, The City Council has been informed of his retirement by the Honorable Matthew O'Shea, Alderman of the 19<sup>th</sup> Ward; and

**WHEREAS**, Daniel Schroeder has been dedicated to Physical Education for over 40 years; and

**WHEREAS**, Daniel was born on August 4<sup>th</sup>, 1951. He attended St. Rita High School as a part of the all-Catholic football league with a four-year football scholarship. After graduation in 1970, he continued playing football while wearing #67 first as a linebacker, then as an offensive guard at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, where he graduated in 1974 with a degree in Physical Education and Recreation; and



Greenwood Park, Beverly Park, and Tarkington Park, where he implemented programs such as men's softball leagues, little league, soccer, and day camps. He was a supervisor at Marquette Park until his retirement in 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, Daniel also served the Archdiocese of Chicago by teaching Physical Education at Christ the King School for 25 years and recently at St. John Fisher School; and
