ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago is a home rule unit of government under Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 9-64-090(f) of the Code, the following address ranges are designated as buffer zones for a residential parking permit zone (Zone 599). The residents living in the following address ranges, on both sides of the indicated streets, are eligible to acquire a permit to park in the adjacent residential parking permit zone (Zone 599), as a result of insufficient available parking caused by that adjacent zone:

1401 to 2025 S. Michigan Avenue
1600 to 1733 S. Prairie Avenue
1801 to 2035 S. Indiana Avenue
119 to 299 E. 18th Street
1314 to 1358 S. Indiana Parkway

SECTION 2. This ordinance will be in full force and effect upon passage and publication.
