BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

Section 1:

The ordinance passed by the City Council of the City of Chicago for BEVERLY HILLS TENNIS CLUB on 06/11/2008, and printed upon page 29730 of the Journal of Proceedings of the City of Chicago is here by Amended by deleting the words

"Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to BEVERLY HILLS TENNIS CLUB, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Fence on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 9121 S. Hamilton Ave..

Said Fence(s) at S. Hamilton measure(s):

One (1) at two hundred forty-eight (248) feet in length and point six (.6) feet in width for a total of one hundred forty-eight point eight (148.8) square feet."

and inserting in their place the words

"Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to BEVERLY HILLS TENNIS CLUB, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, two (2) Fence(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 9121 S. Hamilton Ave..

Said Fence(s) at S. Hamilton measure(s):

One (1) at two hundred forty-eight (248) feet in length, and point five (.5) feet in width for a total of one hundred twenty-four (124) square feet.

One (1) at ten (10) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of ten (10) square feet. "

Section 2:

This ordinance Amendment shall be in effect upon its passage.
