WHEREAS, Dr. Weldon Beverly, Jr., was a pioneering Chicago educator and administrator; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Weldon Beverly, Jr., was the much-adored father of Susan and Kathryn and the grandfather of one to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities that he possessed in abundance; and

WHEREAS, A native of Indianapolis, Indiana, Dr. Weldon Beverly, Jr., graduated from Texas College and earned his doctorate degree from the University of Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of Dr. Weldon Beverly, Jr., serve as an example to all; and


