25	South Throop Street and West Taylor Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [Or2020-3]
25	West 18 <sup>th</sup> Street and South Allport Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [Or2020-4]
25	South Paulina Street and West Cermak Road; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [Or2020-5]
25	South Laflin Street and West Cermak Road; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [Or2020-6]
30	North Moody Avenue and West Schubert Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches -- (19-02114839) [Or2019-444]
39	North Sawyer Avenue and North Berwyn Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [O2020-68]
