WHEREAS, Thomas J. Boyle, Jr., was the much-adored father of Ryan to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities which he possessed in abundance; and

WHEREAS, A member of the United States Marine Corps, Thomas J. Boyle, Jr., bravely served his country during two tours of duty during the Vietnam War and earned the Cross of Gallantry; and

WHEREAS, A law enforcement professional, Thomas J. Boyle, Jr., retired from the Chicago Police Department after thirty years of dedicated service; and

WHEREAS, Thomas J. Boyle, Jr., came out of retirement to act as a contract Law Enforcement Professional (LEP), and previously served two tours in both Kosovo and Iraq where he provided security and trained police officers; and


WHEREAS, Thomas J. Boyle, Jr., lost his life on June 19, 2012, during an insurgent attack on his base in Afghanistan; and
