LOYOLA UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to LOYOLA UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, six (6) Caisson(s) encroaching under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 16 E. Pearson St..

Said Caisson(s) at North State Street measure(s):

One (1) at one point three three (1.33) foot in length, and point zero eight (.08) feet in width for a total of point one one (.11) square feet. Said caisson shall be approximately seventy-five (75) feet below grade level.

Two (2) at five point zero eight (5.08) feet in length, and one point zero eight (1.08) foot in width for a total of ten point nine seven (10.97) square feet. Said caisson shall be approximately seventy-five (75) feet below grade level.

Three (3) at seven point five eight (7.58) feet in length, and two point zero eight (2.08) feet in width for a total of forty-seven point three (47.3) square feet. Said caisson shall be approximately seventy-five (75) feet below grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).


This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1136399 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 11/13/2018.

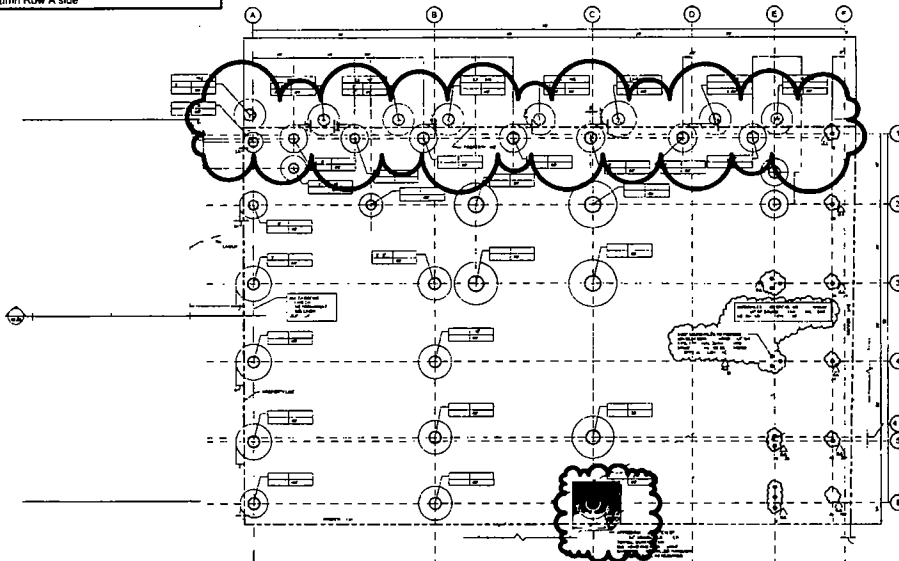

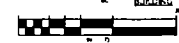
