Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to LOU MALNATI'S PIZZERIA upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 805 S. State St.. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be forty-six point two five (46.25) feet in length and four point six seven (4.67) feet in width for a total of two hundred fifteen point nine nine (215.99) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along S. State. The compensation for said space and the days and hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall be as follows:


Sunday through Thursday 11:00am until 10:00pm Friday & Saturday 11:00am until 11:00pm
