**WHEREAS,** The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

**WHEREAS,** A longtime resident of Oak Park, Raymond F. LeFevour was a widely admired educator and the loving husband for forty-nine years of Dee; and

**WHEREAS,** Raymond F. LeFevour was the much-adored father of Cara, Maura, Edward, Ray, Deirdre, John and Liam, and the grandfather of sixteen to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities that he possessed in abundance; and

**WHEREAS,** Raymond F. LeFevour served for thirteen years as the President of Wilbur Wright Junior College where he established high expectations for academic excellence and oversaw the construction of its new northwest side campus; and

**WHEREAS,** Raymond F. LeFevour retired from the Chicago City Colleges in 2000; and

**WHEREAS,** The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of Raymond F. LeFevour serve as an example to all; and

**WHEREAS,** To his beloved family, Raymond F. LeFevour imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED,** That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this fifteenth day of February, 2012, do hereby commemorate Raymond F. LeFevour for his grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to his family; and
