SUBSTITUTE
ORDINANCE

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the areas described in Section 2 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the area.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (27.410), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of March 18, 2009 at pages 56099 through 56101, with the following underscored text:

(27.410) On both sides of Chicago Avenue, from Noble Street to Greenview Avenue thence on the south side only of Chicago Avenue, from Greenview Avenue to Ashland Avenue.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon passage and publication.


