ORDINANCE ADVOCATE ILLINOIS MASONIC MEDICAL CENTER Acct. No. 63145 - 1 Permit No. 1099862

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to ADVOCATE ILLINOIS MASONIC MEDICAL CENTER, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use six (6) sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 836 W. Wellington Ave...

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along W Wellington (east side): One (1) at thirty-eight (38) feet in length, five point six seven (5.67) feet in height and thirty-five (35) feet above grade level.

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along W Wellington (west side):

One (1) at thirty-eight (38) feet in length, five point six seven (5.67) feet in height and thirty-five (35) feet above grade level.

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along N Halsted St:

One (1) at two point five (2.5) feet in length, three point zero eight (3.08) feet in height and twelve (12) feet above grade level.

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along Between W Wellington and West Nexson St: One (1) at three point five (3.5) feet in length, three point five (3.5) feet in height and nine (9) feet above grade level.

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along W Wellington:

One (1) at three point five (3.5) feet in length, three point five (3.5) feet in height and twelve (12) feet above grade level.

One (1) at eleven point three three (11.33) feet in length, eleven point three three (11.33) feet in height and forty (40) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1099862 herein granted the sum of one thousand seventy-five (\$1,075.00) per aprium in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date

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
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The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
