WHEREAS, Eleanor Green, an outstanding public servant and member of her community, has devoted more than 33 years of service, particularly to the schoolchildren of this city; and


WHEREAS, Eleanor Green served with distinction as a Crossing Guard in the Chicago Police Department from March 27, 1978 to June 17, 2011; and
