WHEREAS, Dolores enjoys traveling and spending time with her 10 grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren; she credits her long life to her strong faith, healthy eating, and positive attitude, and to writing letters, keeping up with the world's events, and a full social life; and

WHEREAS, Dolores is an amazing, loving, caring, strong woman who has touched many lives with her joyous attitude and wisdom; and

WHEREAS, Dolores' previous birthday celebrations have brought numerous family and friends from locations across the US and Mexico; this year, her family was creative and held a drive-by celebration due to the pandemic; now, therefore
