ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 8-16-020 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

8-16-020 Curfew hours for minors.

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

- Penalties. A person who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a separate offense for each day or part of a day during which the violation is committed, continued, or permitted. Each offense, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or an order to perform community service pursuant to Section 1-4-120 of this Code, or both. Any person who violates any provision of this section three times in any twelve-month period shall be subject to up to three times the maximum monetary fine set forth in this subsection for any subsequent violation of this section within the twelve-month period, as an alternative or in addition to a requirement to perform community service and/or attend supportive social services.
- Upon determining that a person has violated this section three or more times within a twelve-month period, the superintendent of police or his designee shall provide the offending party with reference information for supportive social services.

2. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication.
