WHEREAS, Dr. James W. West has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of ninety-eight; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, Dr. James W. West was a widely admired member of the medical community and the loving husband of Maureen; and

WHEREAS, Dr. James W. West was the much-adored father of six children and two stepchildren, the grandfather of nine and the great-grandfather of four to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities which he possessed in abundance; and

WHEREAS, A pioneer in the fields of organ transplant and addiction treatment, Dr. James W. West earned his medical degree from Loyola University and had a surgical career which spanned four decades; and

WHEREAS, In 1950, while a surgeon at Little Company of Mary Hospital in Evergreen Park, Dr. James W. West played a significant role in one of the nation's first successful kidney transplants; and

WHEREAS, A native of Chicago, Dr. James W. West was a recovering alcoholic who used his personal experience to improve and promote substance abuse programs; and

WHEREAS, Dr. James W. West taught psychiatry at the University of Chicago and Rush Medical School and helped found Chicago's Haymarket Center; and

WHEREAS, Dr. James W. West will be remembered by his friends and colleagues as a healer, teacher, and friend; and

WHEREAS, To his beloved family, Dr. James W. West imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this twelfth day of September, 2012, do hereby commemorate Dr. James W. West for his grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to his family; and
