WHEREAS, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of Joseph V. Roddy serve as an example to all; and

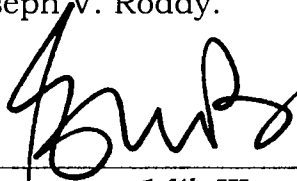
