ORDINANCE LASALLE PARTNERS MGMT., LTD. Acct. No. 82047 - 1 Permit No. 1119447

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to LASALLE PARTNERS MGMT., LTD., upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, eleven (11) Caisson bells under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 633 N. St Clair St..

Existing caisson bells encroachments extend one hundred twenty-seven (127) square feet under the public way. Eight (8) caisson bells under and along North St Clair Street and three (3) caisson bells under and along East Ontario Street.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1119447 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.


A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 05/16/2015.
