*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to SUKHADIA SWEETS N SNACKS, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use three (3) sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 2559 W. Devon Ave..

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along W. Devon Avenue:

One (1) at three point three three (3.33) feet in length, four point five (4.5) feet in height and twelve point one six (12.16) feet above grade level.

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along W. Devon Avenue:

One (1) at fourteen (14) feet in length, four point three three (4.33) feet in height and twelve point three three (12.33) feet above grade level.

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along N. Rockwell Street:

One (1) at fourteen (14) feet in length, four point three three (4.33) feet in height and twelve point three three (12.33) feet above grade level.

The location of said ~~privilege~~ shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said ~~privilege~~ shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of ~~privilege~~ in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the ~~privilege~~ #1135425 herein granted the sum of seven hundred (\$700.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

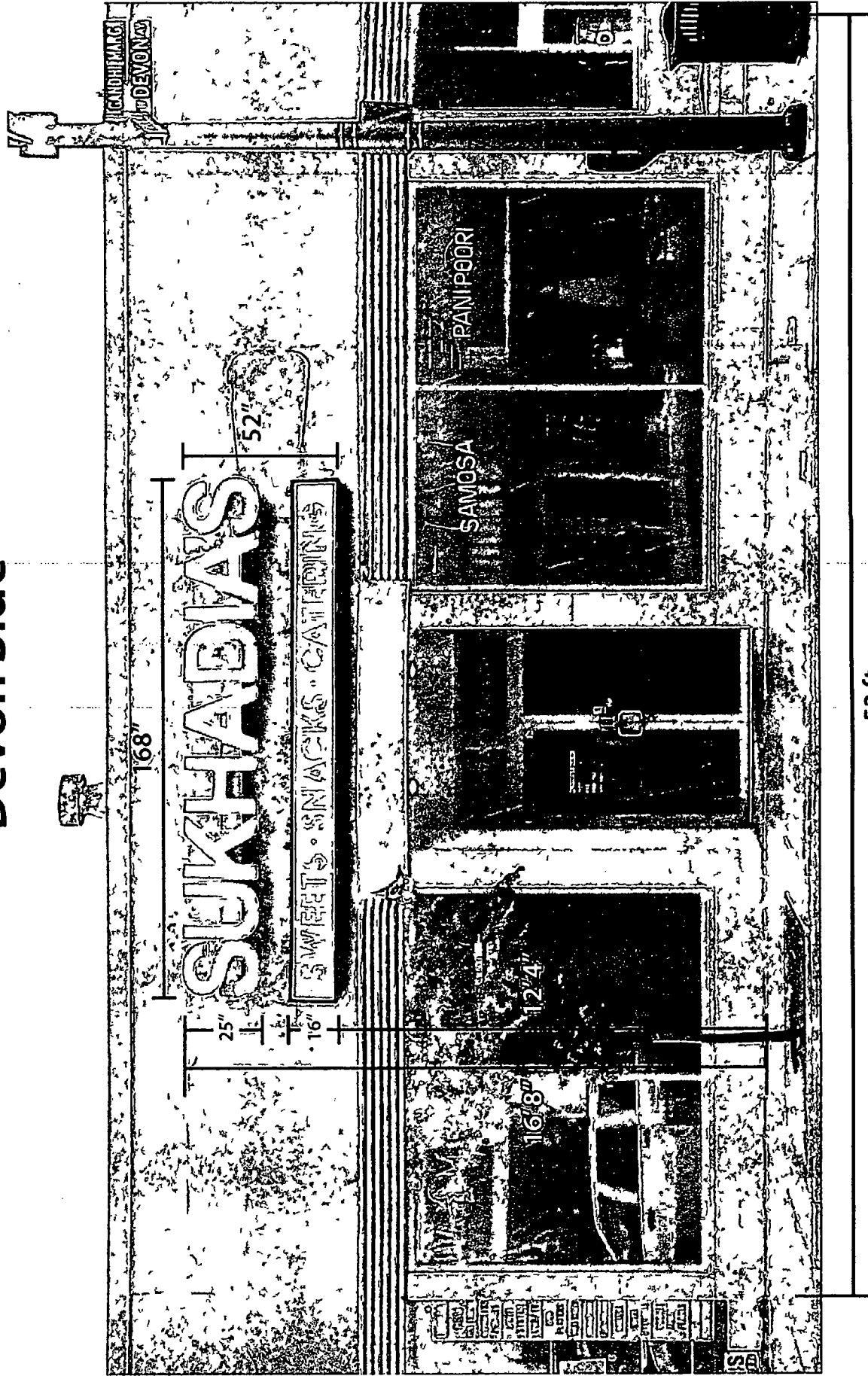
The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
