ORDINANCE DOG HAUS Acct. No 417650 - 1 Permit No. 1132168

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago.

Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to DOG HAUS upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 2464 N. Lincoln Ave.. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be twenty-eight (28) feet in length and three point eight three (3.83) feet in width for a total of one hundred seven point two four (107.24) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along N. LINCOLN AVENUE. The compensation for said space and the days and hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall be as follows:

Sunday thru Thursday 11:00 a.m. to 10.00 p.m. Friday thru Saturday 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.

Compensation: \$600.00 SEATING CAPACITY: 8

THE REPORT OF THE PARTY OF THE

Sidewalk Cafe Permit and approved plan must be posted at all times

This grant of privilege #1132168 for a sidewalk cafe shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-800 though 10-28-885 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the directions of the Commissioner of Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, and the Commissioner of Transportation.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority for the above named privilege is herein given and granted from and after March 1, 2018 through and including December 1, 2018.
