THE NORTHERN TRUST COMPANY

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to THE NORTHERN TRUST COMPANY, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Pedestrian Bridge projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 50 S. La Salle St..

Said Pedestrian Bridge at West Arcade Place measure(s):

One (1) at eighteen (18) feet in length, and twelve (12) feet in width for a total of two hundred sixteen (216) square feet.

Existing pedestrian bridge is located approximately thirty-three (33) feet west of the west line of South LaSalle Street and run over and across West Arcade Place at the sixth (6th) story level of said premises for a distance of approximately eighteen (18) feet in length. Existing pedestrian bridge connect the 50 South La Salle Street building with the premises known as 10 South La Salle Street and is fifteen (15) feet in height and twelve (12) feet in width.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1114535 herein granted the sum of two thousand seventy-four (\$2,074.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 02/25/2013.
