**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Thomas A. Schermerhorn practiced law until serving as a highly respected judge for more than 20 years; and


**WHEREAS,** Throughout his tenure, the Honorable Thomas A. Schermerhorn upheld the finest and most noble traditions of public service; and
