
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1.

Pursuant to Section 10-20-430 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to exempt **Eduardo M. Ortiz Barrionuevo** of **Chicagocarclinic.com** from the provisions requiring barriers as a prerequisite to prohibit alley ingress and egress to **5912 West Addison Street**.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
