WHEREAS, The Honorable Paul Sandoval has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of sixty-seven; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Paul Sandoval was a widely admired political leader and the devoted husband of the Honorable Paula; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Paul Sandoval was the much-adored father of Kendra, Cris, Andrea, Amanda, and Brett to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities which he possessed in abundance; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Paul Sandoval was a Colorado State Senator from 1975 through 1982 and the first Latino to serve as a member of the Legislative Joint Budget Committee; and

WHEREAS, A respected member of Denver's business community, the Honorable Paul Sandoval operated a successful restaurant, La Casita; and

WHEREAS, Known for his progressive politics and savvy business sense, the Honorable Paul Sandoval was a friend and mentor to many; and

WHEREAS, To his beloved family, the Honorable Paul Sandoval imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this ninth day of May, 2012, do hereby commemorate the Honorable Paul Sandoval for his grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to his family; and
