ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago is a home rule unit of government under Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 9-64-090(f) of the Code, the following address range is designated as a buffer zone for a residential parking permit zone (Zone 1211). The residents living in the following address range, on both sides of the indicated street, are eligible to acquire a permit to park in the adjacent residential parking permit zone (Zone 1211), as a result of insufficient available parking caused by that adjacent zone:

19 to 50 E. 26th Street

SECTION 2. This ordinance will be in full force and effect upon passage and publication.
