WHEREAS, Britney Rachelle Meux has gone to her eternal reward at the age of twenty-five; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of her passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, A resident of Indiana, Britney Rachelle Meux was the beloved daughter of Jacqueline Meux and Herbert Bailey; and

WHEREAS, Britney Rachelle Meux was the much-adored mother of five-month-old Savannah Bailey Hardiman; and

WHEREAS, A Corrections Officer with the Lake County Sheriff's Department in Crown Point, Indiana, Britney Rachelle Meux was struck and fatally injured by an SUV while jogging with co-workers; and

WHEREAS, A former United States Marine, Britney Rachelle Meux was employed by the Indiana Department of Corrections for three years; and

WHEREAS, Britney Rachelle Meux was a 2004 graduate of Lew Wallace High School where she excelled at cheerleading and track and field; and

WHEREAS, Britney Rachelle Meux joined the United States Marine Corps in 2006 and prided herself on becoming as physically fit as possible; and

WHEREAS, A student at Calumet College of St. Joseph, Britney Rachelle Meux would have graduated in May 2012 with a degree in public safety management; and

WHEREAS, Co-workers of Britney Rachelle Meux described her as an irreplaceable employee with a contagious smile; and

WHEREAS, Hundreds of law enforcement officers from around the country traveled to Indiana to pay their final respects to Britney Rachelle Meux; and

WHEREAS, To her beloved family, Britney Rachelle Meux imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this fourteenth day of March, 2012, do hereby commemorate Britney Rachelle Meux for her grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to her family; and
