***WHEREAS***, A resident of Indiana, Britney Rachelle Meux was the beloved daughter of Jacqueline Meux and Herbert Bailey; and

***WHEREAS***, Britney Rachelle Meux was the much-adored mother of five-month-old Savannah Bailey Hardiman; and

***WHEREAS***, A Corrections Officer with the Lake County Sheriff's Department in Crown Point, Indiana, Britney Rachelle Meux was struck and fatally injured by an SUV while jogging with co-workers; and

***WHEREAS***, A former United States Marine, Britney Rachelle Meux was employed by the Indiana Department of Corrections for three years; and

***WHEREAS***, Britney Rachelle Meux was a 2004 graduate of Lew Wallace High School where she excelled at cheerleading and track and field; and

***WHEREAS***, Britney Rachelle Meux joined the United States Marine Corps in 2006 and prided herself on becoming as physically fit as possible; and

***WHEREAS***, A student at Calumet College of St. Joseph, Britney Rachelle Meux would have graduated in May 2012 with a degree in public safety management; and


***WHEREAS***, Co-workers of Britney Rachelle Meux described her as an irreplaceable employee with a contagious smile; and
