
**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

Our letter dated NOVEMBER 2002, stated you would be exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and you would be treated as a public charity, rather than as a private foundation, during an advance ruling period.



## NOTICE TO METERED WATER EXEMPT CUSTOMERS

Effective September 6, 1984, Chapter 185.1 Section 2(A) of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago was amended to provide for a \$500.00 semi-annual sewer charge billing exemption for qualified institutions.

The billing period for your account is reflected on the enclosed bill. The \$500.00 semi-annual exemptions have been subtracted from your bill on a per day basis. Any sewer charge prior to September 6, 1984, or in excess of the 1985 exemptions is reflected on the bill. This amount is due and payable.

Semi-annual sewer billing will commence in 1986. For further information please call 744-7076.
