E-drop Off Express

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to E-drop Off Express, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use three (3) sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 2117 N. Halsted St..

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along N. Halsted Street:  
Three (3) at one point six (1.6) feet in length, one point six (1.6) feet in height and nine (9) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1094562 herein granted the sum of one hundred seventy-five (\$175.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.

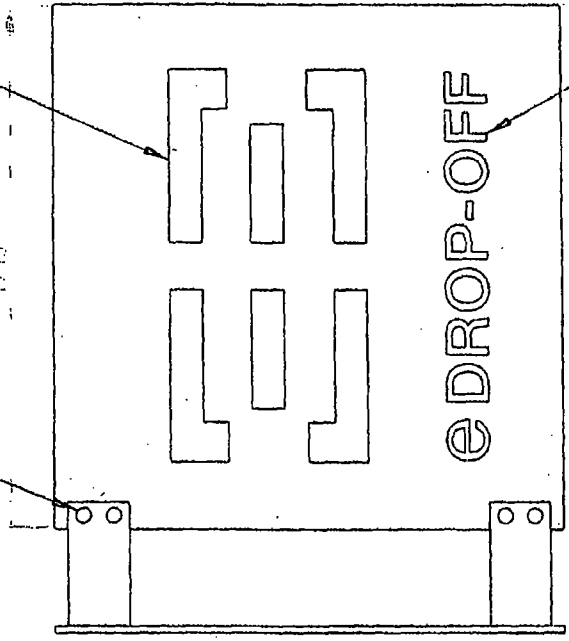
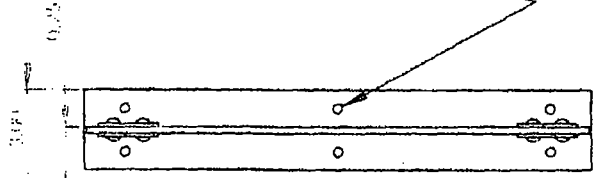
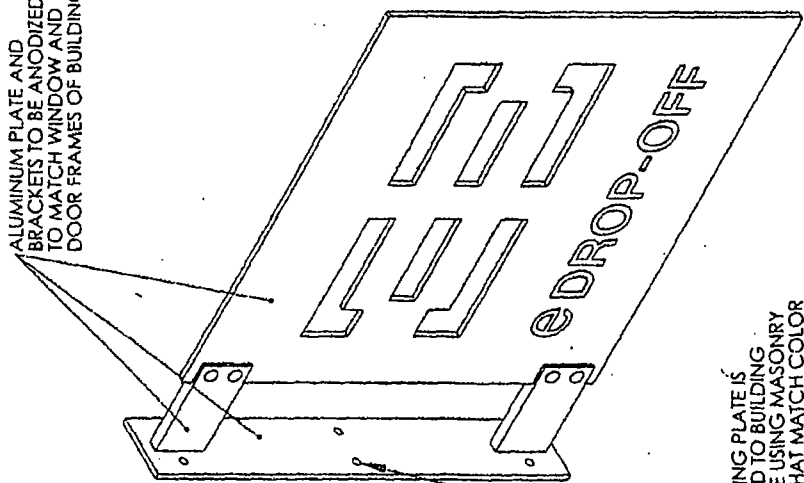

PLATE COMPONENT IS MOUNTED TO BRACKETS WITH DOMED BOLTS THAT MATCH COLOR OF PLATE AND BRACKETS.

GEOMETRIC SHAPES ARE CUT THROUGH ALUMINIUM PLATE.

MOUNTING PLATE IS SECURED TO BUILDING FACADE USING MASONRY BOLTS THAT MATCH COLOR OF PLATE AND BRACKETS.



LETTER FORMS ARE APPLIED VIA SILK SCREENING PROCESS TO MATCH PANTONE COOL GRAY 1C.

NOTE: TOTAL AREA OF SIGN IS 2.11 SQ. FT. PER SIDE. NOT INCLUDING THE BRACKETS. THE SIGN WILL EXTEND 23.05" OVER THE SIDEWALK, MEASURED FROM THE FRONT MASONRY SURFACE OF THE BUILDING'S FACADE.
