## **RESOLUTION**

*WHEREAS,* The Honorable Rubel Phillips has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of eighty-six; and

*WHEREAS,* The City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman *E*dward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Rubel Phillips was a pioneering member of the Republican Party in the State of Mississippi and the loving husband of Margaret; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Rubel Phillips was the much-adored father of two sons and the grandfather of two to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities which he possessed in abundance; and

*WHEREAS,* A native of Alcorn County, the Honorable Rubel Phillips earned his law degree from the University of Mississippi; and

*WHEREAS,* The Honorable Rubel Phillips served as Circuit Clerk of Alcorn County and as a member of the Mississippi Public Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, The leadership and vision of the Honorable Rubel Phillips was largely responsible for the rejuvenation of Mississippi's Republican Party during the 1950s and 1960s; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Rubel Phillips entered private law practice in 1958 and served from 1979 to 1990 as an in-house counsel and consultant for Mobile Communications Corporation of America; and

WHEREAS, The hard work and dedication of the Honorable Rubel Phillips serve as an example to all; and

*WHEREAS,* The Honorable Rubel Phillips will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by his many relatives, friends and colleagues; and

*WHEREAS,* To his beloved family, the Honorable Rubel Phillips imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED**, That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this sixth day of July, 2011, do hereby commemorate the Honorable **R**ubel Phillips for his grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to his family; and
